   500,000 patients in Europe






- 1. Forgetfulness

- 2. Analysis, modelling, and prediction of disease symptoms
- 3. Thanks to immediate feedback, alarms, educational component, interaction with others, myAirCoach will be extremely helpful in modifying patients' attitude towards adherence

#### Call to Action on Allergy & Asthma

- Public health implementing EU strategies and programmes across MS
- Funding for research
- Prevention and early diagnosis
- Root cause analysis of diseases (air quality, food allergens, chemicals)
- Personalised medicine (individualised treatment)
- Economic benefit (reducing direct and indirect costs on health systems and society)
