The management of asthma requires understanding the underlying conditions, knowledge about specific triggers, recognition of symptoms/signs and a tailored treatment. Asthma control remains relatively poor in Europe and across the world, and patients do not always have access to sufficiently accurate educational resources to help manage the disease. This webinar is the occasion to discuss the importance of **asthma health literacy** and of having **access to scientifically validated information** designed and written for asthma patients and families. After a roundtable session with representatives from the asthma patient community and medical doctors, the event will move to the presentation of the new website **aboutasthma.org** that is intended to facilitate access to updated information for patients to better understand asthma management and care.
