Atopic dermatitis/eczema (AD/E) is considered the most common inflammatory skin disease, affecting up to 20% of children and adolescents worldwide. In Europe, its prevalence has steadily increased over the last four decades.

THE ATOPIC ECZEMA CONSENSUS EUROPE PROJECT

Despite its prevalence, AD/E Is poorly understood by many, limiting progress in improving quality-of-life. The European Federation of Allergies and Airways Diseases Patients' Associations (EFA) ran a consensus project in 2022 to change this precarious situation and recognise that AD/E is a complex chronic disease, for which patients require long-term treatment and multidisciplinary care to cope with it.

THE CONSENSUS COMMITTEE EUROPE

The Consensus Committee was formed by 15 key opinion leaders in the field of AD/E in a diverse and representative group, including dermatologists, psychologists, dieticians, nurses, paediatricians, GPs and, crucially, patients and carers.

Together, they reviewed the burden of AD/E through literature and best practices, discussed practical solutions and listened to one another's experiences. The results of their consensus is what created the report.

THE CONSENSUS EUROPE REPORT

The Consensus Report is an evidence-based report, which combines science with storytelling. It reflects the true burden of the disease and sets out a clear path for making sustainable changes in our healthcare systems.

At EFA, we hope this report can be a tool for all stakeholders, including patients and healthcare professionals, to advocate for access to services and to enhance the quality of care available to the AD/E community in Europe.
