2010: The Year of the Lung Declaration

6 December 2009, Cancun, Mexico

 Hundreds of millions of people struggle each year for life and breath due to lung diseases, including tuberculosis, asthma, pneumonia, influenza, lung cancer and chronic obstructive pulmonary disorder, and more than 10 million die.

Lung diseases afflict people in every country and every socioeconomic group, but take the heaviest toll on the poor, the old, the young and the weak;

WE RECOGNIZE THAT:

Tobacco use remains legal, although it kills more than 5 million people each year, including 3.5 million who die of COPD, and it affects the health of hundreds of thousands of others who are exposed to its effects secondhand;




2010 The Year of the Lung






Definition of COPD The Year of the Lung

- COPD is a preventable and treatable disease with some significant extrapulmonary effects that may contribute to the severity in individual patients.
- Its pulmonary component is characterized by airflow limitation that is not fully reversible.
- The airflow limitation is usually progressive and associated with an abnormal inflammatory response of the lung to noxious particles or gases.








Raising awareness


